**Lent Lunch 2019** will be on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> March in the Methodist Hall, Shaldon from 10.30am until the soup runs out! This year we will be supporting the charity Solar Aid, which aims to combat poverty and climate change by providing solar lights in the East African countries of Malawi, Uganda and Zambia to the many people who have no access to electric light. **Holy Week Quiet Day – Fri. 12<sup>th</sup>. April 10.00 am – 3.00 pm.** As a way to observe the importance of Holy Week and to prepare for the solemnity of Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Day, we are going to hold a **Quiet Day in St. Peter's for the whole benefice**. It is also open to members of the other Churches, who will be most welcome. We will begin with a short time of prayer and an address, followed by a period of silence. At midday we will in spirit walk the Via Dolorosa, the Way of the Cross, and then have lunch. After some more time for meditation we shall join in the Eucharist with another address, coming to an end at 3.00 pm. The theme will be "Watch and Pray" and the three sessions will centre on watching in Gethsemane, watching Jesus' journey to Calvary and watching on that Friday evening. Books and pictures will be provided for you to use during the silences and you can, of course, bring a Bible and other reading matter – of a spiritual nature, of course! A pen and some paper are often helpful to jot down your thoughts. Coffee and tea will be available all day, but please bring your own lunch. Lists are available in each church for you to indicate whether you are going to take part. It is obviously of greatest value if you can stay for the whole time but, if you can only manage an hour or two, that will be fine. I do hope many of you will be able to take up Jesus' own invitation to "Stop here and stay awake with me". Revd. Caroline


